



PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

Parking in UNH Law lots is by permit only. Non-overnight Parking permits are free of charge and issued to students, faculty and staff upon receipt of a completed application. There are a limited number of OVERNIGHT Permits available for a fee of \$50 per semester. Parking permits are valid between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. in all lots owned by UNH Law. All lots are closed between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Vehicles parked in any UNH Law lots without an overnight permit between the hours of 1:00 am and 6:00 am may be towed without notice at the owner's expense. Students with the overnight 24 hour/7day week parking pass, further agree to move the tagged vehicle from the lot for any and all snow removal after snowstorms when notified. Notification will be by email or call at your listed phone number. Failure to comply with this requirement/agreement may result in your vehicle being ticketed and/or towed at your expense. UNH Law is not responsible for any cost associated with this requirement. UNH Law maintains the right to suspend or revoke any issued parking permits.

All vehicles parked in any UNH Law parking lots must have:

A valid registration - A valid inspection sticker (if applicable) - A UNH Law parking permit displayed clearly on the vehicle.
